General

- Everyone should be on the float at the staging area ready to roll at 9:45 with the engine running and the staging area clean.
- No GLASS Bottles – please bring plastic for Safety
- No climbing or sitting on side rails - No hanging over the sides of the float
- No hanging around back steps area - No tampering with the generator
- No getting on and off the float during the parade
- Riders MUST refrain from any activity on or within the float which may be considered obscene, profane or socially offensive
- Be considerate of your neighbors while riding the float

Throwing:

- Do not start throwing until you cross over Acadian Thruway. That is where the start of the parade is.
- Pace your throwing. When you make it to Perkins at Terrace you are "bead-wise" 1/3 of the way through. You may run out if you start too early.
- Riders should try not to drop throws too closely to the float – children tend to dart toward the float to catch them
- No throwing obscene, large articles or throwing food – EVEN IF IT IS THROWN AT YOU!!! DO NOT THROW IT BACK!!!!
- No shooting toilet paper or using silly string.

Trash

- Police the area around our float at the staging area prior to the parade starting – we are guests of this neighborhood – please leave it as you found it!!
- Bring garbage bags and be responsible for cleaning your area at the end of the parade

Underage Children

- Parents MUST ride with children – NO EXCEPTIONS
- Parents must accompany small children to the port-a-potty
